This report concerns the following Mental Health Task Group priorities:-

- Support for Thrive Kingston (Kingston's Mental Health Strategy - since 2017/18 - ongoing)
- Enter & View of Tolworth Hospital Community Service (from 2017-18)
- Review of Kingston iCope Service (2018/19)
- Review of young people's transition from CAMHS to Adult Services (2019/20)
- Provision of EUPD Services (2016/17)

Support for Thrive Kingston

A meeting is being sought with representatives of Richmond and Kingston CCG (R&KCCG) to review objective for Thrive Kingston as we move from year 2 to year 3.

Healthwatch Kingston, MIND in Kingston and RBK presented a bid to National MIND for funds to establish Kingston as a funded Time to Change borough. This was successful, and activities are underway to develop capabilities and governance to deliver Time to Change Kingston (TTCK).

Enter & View of Tolworth Hospital Community Service

A copy of the published E&V report was provided to the new Service Manager at Tolworth, Shaun Hare. A meeting to review recommendations has been requested.

Review of Kingston iCope Service

The review is now operational. Marketing has been undertaken via online and conventional channels, and paper, online and interview surveys have been received.

Review of young people's transition from CAMHS to Adult Services

The MHTG priority setting process has identified the transition of young people from CAMHS to Adult Services as its preferred focus, with a particular emphasis on the experiences of neurotypical and neurodiverse young people. A workshop is being organised to develop a research question and a stakeholder analysis.

Provision of EUPD Services

A business case for an interim PD service was approved by the CCG Finance Committee and the Trust is progressing implementing the service from April 19.
