

3. Annual Health Checks and Health Action Plans


The group looked at the findings of the annual health check and health action plan surveys which Healthwatch have been asking people with a learning disability to fill in.

It was said that peoples support workers are also not helpful in supporting this, because they are not aware that it is peoples right and they are not aware of what the health check includes.

It would be helpful if all support workers got a checklist to check the person they care for gets the check done properly.

It was also said GP receptionists often don't seem to know about the health checks so are not helpful in booking the appointments.

It was planned at the last meeting that a letter should be sent to all GP surgeries to find out if they provide health checks properly.
