



Projects volunteer

Builds reports which have meaningful recommendations in the borough.

Role dependent on project, may involve:

- Prepare for and conduct surveys, consultations and visits
- Compile results
- Building reports and publications
- Telephone operation

Events volunteer

Stalls and community engagement.

- Listen to and collect what people say about their experiences.
- Raise awareness.
- Different venues around the borough.

Office volunteer

Support and administration

- Taking notes
- Company e-mails
- Data entry
- Answering telephone
- Staff support at KQC
- If you could spare: Time dependent on availability.
